

# November 24 & 25 and December 1 & 2

## Demonstration Project

Each student chose a Science Demonstration to present to their class. Then they were assigned a presentation date of either November 24 or 25, or December 1 or 2. On the assigned day each student will bring in their materials as well as their written report. They will have between 5 and 10 minutes to teach their lesson to the class. They will be graded on how well the demonstration works as well as their ability to explain the scientific concept being demonstrated and to answer questions. We worked three days in class, but the scope of the project requires students to complete their work at home. If you have any questions, ask to see the handout given to each student on day one, or contact me here at the school.

Any parent interested in visiting the class on the day of their child's presentation is welcome to come. Enter the building through the north, Sheridan Street door and pick up a visitors pass in the office. If details can be worked out, I would like to take some of the students to the elementary classrooms to share their projects.

Ask which day your child has been assigned to demonstrate and remind them to bring their project on that day.
